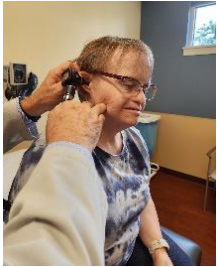


Getting Ear Wax Removed

The doctor looked in my ears and I have a lot of wax.



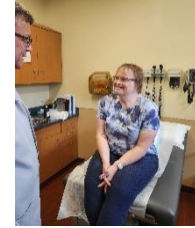
The doctor wants to take the wax out.

If I need a break. I can ask the doctor to stop.



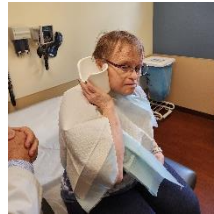
If I have questions, I can ask the doctor.
