The Adult Down Syndrome Center currently has a research study that may interest you.

Dr. Chicoine is conducting a sequel study assessing the effectiveness of the use of videos in patient education **for** adults with Down syndrome. While there are health education materials available for families and there is less information specifically for people with Down syndrome to promote independence and good health practices.

There are 3 visits in total- the enrollment visit, 1 month follow up and 2 months follow up. Additionally, the participant will be asked to view the education video on a provided research tablet at home daily for that first month and keep a study-provided checklist.

There are some additional inclusion and exclusion requirements for this study.

1. Ability to use and complete a daily checklist
2. Ability to learn to use a tablet device
3. *Access to internet connection*
4. Willingness to return for the 1 month and 2 months follow up assessment recordings.
